

## The Russians are celebrating at the Old Museum!

The Brisbane Philharmonic Orchestra performs a special concert as part of the B150 celebrations at the Old Museum Concert Hall, Bowen Hills 2pm Sunday 20 September.

The concert will also celebrate the orchestras' move to the Old Museum Building as their new permanent home in the heart of Bowen Hills and the majestic lady of Brisbane!

Featuring favourite works by Russian composers, the concert will feature one of the orchestra's most loved young pianists, Philip Eames.

Philip Eames was born in 1986 and is currently undertaking a Master of Music degree at the Queensland Conservatorium of Music, having been awarded the Bachelor of Music in Advanced Performance with First Class Honours in 2008. During this time he studied piano under Max Olding and previously Stephen Savage, and has studied Chamber Music under Marcus Stocker, Peter Luff and Stephen Emmerson.

Philip has performed both as soloist and chamber musician in numerous music festivals throughout Australia, and is the recipient of many notable prizes and scholarships including 1st Place in the 2008 Queensland Piano Competition, 1st Place in the Chamber Music sections of the 2008 and 2009 Australian Concerto and Aria Competitions, the 2008 Ross Peters 4MBS Chamber Music Prize, the 2008 Australian Concerto and Aria Competition Open section, the 2007 South-East Queensland Concerto and Aria competition, and the Keys Festival of Australian Music, 2006.

Additionally, he was awarded the 2008 Fred Ellaway Prize for the highest achieving piano student at the Queensland Conservatorium. He appeared as soloist with the Brisbane Philharmonic orchestra in 2008, performing Carl Vine's Piano Concerto under conductor Philip Davis.

Philip is a member of numerous ensembles, including the Alembic Piano Trio and Quartet, the Queensland Wind Orchestra, as well as the Ignations musical theatre company. He is highly active as soloist, chamber musician, orchestral pianist, accompanist and repetiteur, and has a great interest in contemporary classical music, frequently commissioning and performing original works by Australian composers.
